## **5S Self Evaluation Checklist**

## **5S Indicators**

The following indicators will be used for assessment of implementation of 5S practice

- 01. Employees are aware of 5S
- 02. Hospital is free from unwanted items
- 03. Central stores established for unwanted and unserviceable items
- 04. Guidelines and schedules are established for sorting and disposal
- 05. Hospital appears organized
- 06. Directions to facilities of the hospital are indicated at the entrance
- 07. Locating have been named
- 08. Items have inventory labels
- 09. Visual controls including color coding is practiced
- 10. Infrastructure is free of hazards i.e. roofs, wiring are maintained safely
- 11. Hospital is clean at all areas
- 12. Color coded waste bins are available throughout the hospital
- 13. Cleaning maps and schedules are available
- 14. Appropriate cleaning tools are available
- 15. Standardized warning signs are practiced
- 16. Clinical and other processes are standardized
- 17. Checklists are used for inspection
- 18. Quality circles are formed are each unit
- 19. Monthly inspections have been carried out by the senior management and by quality circles
- 20. Indicators have been developed to assess progress
- 21. Monthly discussion have been carried out on Five-S by senior management and quality circles
- 22. Inter-unit competitions and rewarding are practiced

## To assess overall quality

- 01. Customer satisfaction indicator (based on a survey)
- 02. Mortality rates
- 03. Avoidable death rates
- 04. Infection rates
- 05. Case fatality rates e.g. for infections, for diarrhea etc.
- 06. Percentage of capital budget for improving infrastructure for patients and to acquire medical equipment
- 07. Average hospital stay
- 08. Bed occupancy rates
- 09. Level of employee satisfaction (based on a survey)
- 10. Level of absenteeism
- 11. Percentage of ESR investigations done at overtime rate
- 12. Percentage of the value of drugs and consumables missing (pilferage) at the annual stock take
- 13. Cost of drugs per inpatient
- 14. Number of innovations initiative % of annual capital budget utilized
- 15. Timely submission of reports and budget requirements to higher authority
